

SNOOKER SHOOTOUT 2022

Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. By participating in the tournament, you are agreeing to these tournament rules and regulations.
2. Free entry for R°SSA members (paid membership by 08/01/2022)
3. \$80 entry fee for non-members/public.
4. Entries close at 11:59pm on 09/01/2022
5. Guaranteed Prize Pool \$14,000:
 - Champion \$7,000
 - Runner Up \$3,000
 - Semi-Finalist \$1,000
 - Quarter-Finalist \$500Special Prizes:
 - High Break (80 & Above) \$1,000
 - Maximum Break \$10,000
6. Champion of Snooker Shootout 2022 gets to play Ronnie O'Sullivan in a Single Frame battle for a chance to increase his/her prize money to \$15,000.
7. Format – Single Frame Knock-out
8. Random unseeded draw to be published by 15/01/2022. Once published, there can be no alterations to the draw.
9. All players will be scheduled to play either Saturday 22nd or Sunday 23rd January. Each quarter of the draw will play down to two players. After the first round of matches, all matches will roll-on as tables become available. Winners need to be available for their next match when it is called – do not leave the venue without permission from the Tournament Director.
10. Players who cannot be located within 10 minutes of their match being called will forfeit the match.
11. Matches up to the quarter final stage will be self-refereed, but roving referees will be available.
12. Quarter finals, Semi-finals and the Final will be played on Friday 28/01/2022 from 7.30pm.
13. Dress Code: Long trousers, covered footwear.
14. When your match is called, collect the match score sheet from the Tournament Director and proceed promptly to the designated table.
15. Each player is permitted three warm-up shots.
16. Once all the reds have been potted, the frame is over if at any stage either player needs 3 or more snookers to win or force a re-spotted black. If two snookers are required to win or force a respotted black, play may continue.
17. Up to the quarter-final stage, the foul-and-a-miss rule will not be applied, but players must make a genuine attempt. From the quarter-final stage, with referees for all matches, the foul-and-a-miss rule will be applied.

18. When the match is finished, please vacate the table area quickly so that the next match can start.
19. The winner has the responsibility to return the completed score sheet to the Tournament Director.
20. On any matter not covered by these rules, the Tournament Director has complete discretion to make a decision in the interests of fairness. No debate will be entered into.

4. Entries close at 11:59pm on 09/01/2022
5. Guaranteed prize pool \$9,240:
 - Champion \$5,000
 - Runner Up \$2,000
 - Semi-Finalist \$400
 - Quarter-Finalist \$160
 - Top 16 \$100
6. Format - Double elimination, Race to 3, Alternate break
7. Standard WPA 9-Ball rules apply, no pattern racking
8. Random unseeded draw to be published by 15/01/2022. Once published, there will be no alterations to the draw.
9. All players will be scheduled to play either Saturday 5th or Sunday 6th February. Each quarter of the draw will play down to two players. After the first round of matches, all matches will roll-on as tables become available. Winners need to be available for their next match when called - do not leave the venue without permission from the Tournament Director.
10. Players who cannot be located within 10 minutes of their match being called will forfeit the match.
11. Matches will be self-refereed
12. Quarter finals, Semi-finals and the Final will be played on Friday 11/02/2022 from 7.45pm.
13. Dress Code: Long trousers, covered footwear.
14. When your match is called, collect the match score sheet from the Tournament Director and proceed promptly to the designated table.
15. Each player is permitted 1 minute to warm up.
16. Should a foul shot be called out without the witness of any player or referee, that shot will be deemed legal.
17. When the match is finished, please vacate the table area quickly, so that the next match can start.
18. It is the winner's responsibility to ensure that the score submitted on CueScore is accurate.
19. On any matters not covered by these rules, the Tournament Director has complete discretion to make a decision in the interests of fairness and there will not be grounds for debate.
